Importance of Yearly Dues

I would like to remind everyone of the importance of your yearly dues payment.

The dues are a key to our Councils operation and helps defer costs to our fund raising efforts. When we do the coat, turkey, and toy drives there is no operations cost. Everything donated passes through. Same as with any collections for disaster relief. Last year our Council 6673 did \$70,000 in charitable work. That big number would be much less with out dues payments to offset operations cost.

The dues cover the per capita charges from the State and Supreme KOFC. Those charges are just under \$10 per member each year. This year we have 150

members that have not paid, which costs our Council nearly \$1500 to cover those per capita charges. Besides that impact, the loss of the remaining \$22 of dues from each non-paying member is \$3300. We could use these funds to support our programs.

Our Council supported five Seminarians this year with \$2500. We could double this very important faith building effort with the remaining dues money if paid.

It is so important, and it is only \$32. Please consider paying your past due payment soon. You can mail your payment to the Parish office:
