The McGivney Project – The McGivney Project helps the homeless restart their lives by helping pay for their monthly rent. Catholic Charities chooses the family to help. CC offers counseling for budgeting and their job search services while we cover the family's first 3 month's rent. We cover 75% of the second quarter, 50% of the third quarter, and 25% of the fourth quarter. We fund Catholic Charities \$10,000 each year to cover these rent payment
