What happened in July 2023? - Knights in Action

The Star Council Award recognizes overall excellence in the areas of membership, promotion of fraternal insurance benefits, sponsorship of faith formation programs, and service-oriented activities.

Brother Mike Stompoly reported that the tournament generated \$33,482.95 in profit for Holy Trinity's St. Vincent DePaul Ministry. The Holy Trinity St. Vincent DePaul ministry is vital in helping local citizens with one-time financial assistance. Thank you to all the volunteers that made the event such a success.

<u>July 2023 Food Drive Results</u> – Our monthly food drive was held on July 15th from 9:00 am until 11:00 a.m. and at 4:00 p.m. Mass and on July 16th before and after all the Masses. This drive resulted in the Knights collecting **2,056 pounds** of food and **\$2,584.00** in cash donations for Catholic Charities of Northeast Kansas.

Father Tom Dolezal and John started the St. Vincent DePaul Society at Holy Trinity in 2003 and he served in the role of Director of the St. Vincent DePaul Society until July of this year. Holy Trinity's St. Vincent de Paul Society Ministry supports the poor and needy within our parish boundaries and strives to meet the needs of the homeless and those in need as they contact our parish. St. Vincent DePaul Society helps provide temporary housing, food, and clothing or assists in finding the appropriate social services agencies. John has also served in the role of Deputy Grand Knight from 2005 to 2007, as our council's Chancellor since 2007, and last year served as the 4th Degree Faithful Navigator. John, thank you for all you have done for our council, St. John's Assembly, our parish, and the community.

Our Family of the Month for July 2023 is Trudy and Rich Boynton.

Rich and Trudy have been members of Holy Trinity since 1996, although Rich is a more recent convert to the faith in 2008. Trudy has been a catechist in the RCIA process almost from their arrival and both Trudy and Rich participated in one of Msgr. Ray Burger's Atchison retreats in 1998; they remain active in the faith group that formed from that retreat. Rich and Trudy each have Adoration hours and in addition, they share an hour together every week. Trudy began the Seven Sisters Apostolate at Holy Trinity which supports each of our parish priests with an hour of adoration every day. Rich and Trudy are both spiritual mentors to many mentees at Holy Trinity and throughout Johnson County. Trudy first proposed the idea of a church gift shop to Fr. Tom 20 years ago and has managed it since the beginning. She was instrumental in establishing Holy Trinity's version of Advent by Candlelight which has drawn 200+ women for the past 7 years in December and has raised thousands of dollars for our local pregnancy centers. Trudy had a vision for a Catholic Women's Conference in the archdiocese and spearheaded the first event for almost 300 women which was held at Holy Trinity in May 2023 and will again return in September 2024. Rich became involved in the RCIA process soon after joining the Church and has been the overall coordinator for the last 10 years. He is part of the 4th Degree Honor Guard, a communion minister, Lector, altar server, and Sacristan, serving at the spaghetti dinner and shrimp dinner, That Man is You, helped with the logistics for the Women's conference also donated his time to the build-a-bed event. Thank you both for all you have done and continue to do for our council, our parish, and the community.
